The only exception to this rule is donations that are mailed to the church on or before the 31st and postmarked no later than December 31, 2022. Donations thus postmarked may be receipted as December donations even though they may arrive in January. A check with a December date on it cannot be receipted as a December donation if it was given to the treasurer after December 31, 2022 or is postmarked in January, 2023. Failure to abide by these IRS requirements could result in loss of the Church's tax deductible status as well as other penalties.


Invite Him in! Escort Him to the seat of honor, and pull out His chair. Clear the table; clear the calendar. Call the kids and neighbors.
