Luke 19:1-9

#### KING JAMES VERSION

**19**<sup>1</sup>And Jesus entered and passed through Jericho. <sup>2</sup>And, behold, there was a man named Zacchaeus, which was the chief among the publicans, and he was rich. <sup>3</sup>And he sought to see Jesus who He was; and could not for the press, because he was little of stature. <sup>4</sup>And he ran before, and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see Him: for He was to pass that way. <sup>5</sup>And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up, and saw him, and said unto him, Zacchaeus, make haste, and come down; for today I must abide at thy house. <sup>6</sup>And he made haste, and came down, and received Him joyfully. <sup>7</sup>And when they saw it, they all murmured, saying, That He was gone to be guest with a man that is a sinner. <sup>8</sup>And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord: Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have taken anything from any man by false accusation, I restore him fourfold. <sup>9</sup>And Jesus said unto him, This day is salvation come to this house, forsomuch as he also is a son of Abraham.

#### NEW LIVING TRANSLATION

**19**<sup>1</sup>Jesus entered Jericho and made His way through the town. <sup>2</sup>There was a man there named Zacchaeus. He was the chief tax collector in the region, and he had become very rich. <sup>3</sup>He tried to get a look at Jesus, but he was too short to see over the crowd. <sup>4</sup>So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore-fig tree beside the road, for Jesus was going to pass that way. <sup>5</sup>When Jesus came by, He looked up at Zacchaeus and called him by name. "Zacchaeus!" He said. "Quick, come down! I must be a guest in your home today." <sup>6</sup>Zacchaeus quickly climbed down and took Jesus to his house in great excitement and joy. <sup>7</sup>But the people were displeased. "He has gone to be the guest of a notorious sinner," they grumbled. <sup>8</sup>Meanwhile, Zacchaeus stood before the Lord and said, "I will give half my wealth to the poor, Lord, and if I have cheated people on their taxes, I will give them back four times as much!" <sup>9</sup>Jesus responded, "Salvation has come to this home today, for this man has shown himself to be a true son of Abraham."
